3. COST TO THE N.S.W. GOVERNMENT

4. LABOUR AND MATERIALS

Pro-Diving Services will supply all diving equipment, air, boats and tools for the construction of the Underwater Nature Trail.

Divers from Marist Brothers! High School Pagewood will provide the labour to construct the nature trail and, subsequently, to maintain it.

Other groups, such as the Pro-Dive Explorers Club and the Sydney University Underwater Society, have expressed their willingness to assist with this project.

5. ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

There will be no material damage to the bay.

There is a parking area already established adjacent to the bay. There is access to the shoreline via a concrete footpath.

The Underwater Nature Trail will not cause any interference to activities such as boating, fishing, sailboarding or surfing in the area.

While the number of divers using the area may increase, the Underwater Nature Trail will serve to improve their knowledge, understanding and appreciation of marine life in the area and their awareness of the need to conserve it.
