CONDITIONS: F1-2, mod. lazy swell, in evening - afternoon. Visibility: 30-40 FT TEMP: Fairly comfortable, slightly overcast, slight breeze.

PRELIMINARY: We met at 9.15 am at Johns Bay discussed the dive plan and set out to locate and mark the positions of the Comanche Bay blocks. Three teams of 2 were issued with a quantity of main floats (light buoys) & tag cord. One team set off in the direction of buoy 11, 3 up whilst the other set off in the direction of 24, 23, 22 up. RESULTS: Buoy blocks 6, 7, 16, 18-19 were located & marked with buoys. A qty of chain & fast latches was found in the vicinity of where buoy block 20 should have been. COMMONS: The main blocks were quite difficult to locate as they have blended into the environment quite well. The actual shape is the only real give away to the actual identity of them. Conditions of the blocks is still good, but the starters eyes are still severe.

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SUGGESTIONS: As last consensus No 44
few of mooring blocks are located they should be joined with new chain in the order that the water buoys are not lost in between locations and the moorings. Finding all of the moorings may take 4 weekends and by then we may have lost some of the moorings. Join up the blocks as we find them may also assist us in finding the other lost moorings. The dive was completed around 11-15am. There were no problems. Angus took all the recovery water buoys with him.
